- 1:03** The Choir sings "Danny Boy" in 2009 at Red Rocks Amphitheatre, Colorado
- 1:28** In 1959 Choir President Lester Hewlett (right) and conductor Richard P. Condie (left) accepted the Grammy Award for the recording of Battle Hymn of the Republic
- 1:31** In July of 1964, announcer Richard L. Evans (left) and Richard P. Condie, conductor (right) accepted gold records for the Choir for the albums, The Lord's Prayer and the Messiah
- 1:41** The Choir received the 1988-89 Rocky Mountain Emmy Award for their program Christmas Sampler with Shirley Verrett as guest performer
- 1:52** Wendell Smoot, Choir president (right) and Jerold Ottley, music director for the Choir (left) display some of the Choir's five gold records and two platinum recordings

- 2:50 The Mormon Tabernacle Choir appeared on the Ed Sullivan Show in 1958
- 2:57 The Choir sang for President John F. Kennedy when he spoke in the Tabernacle in 1963 just before he was assassinated

- 3:04 The Choir performed for President Richard M. Nixon at his inauguration in 1969
